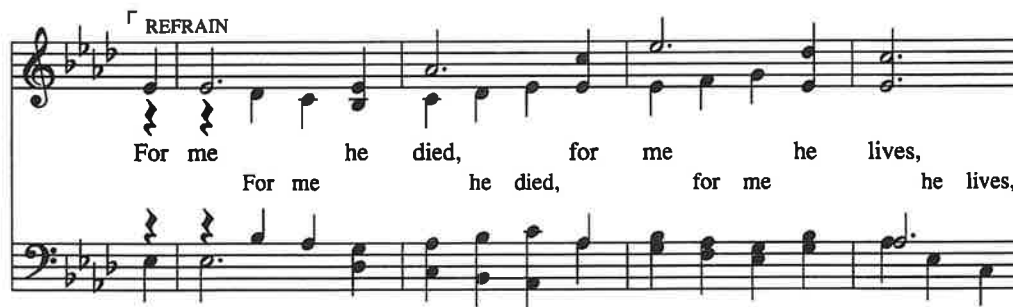
My Hope Is in the Lord

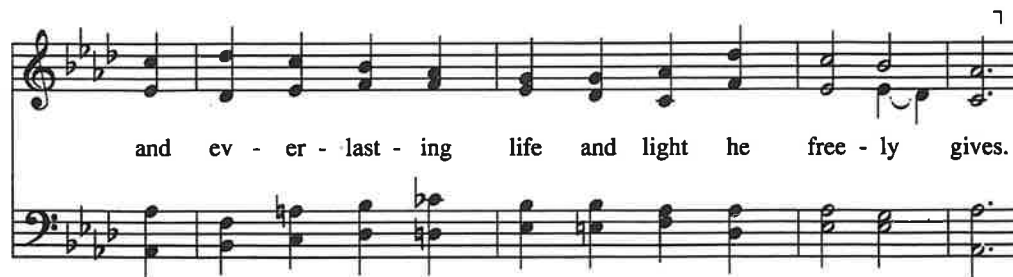
